Rome, April 2011 - The Shareholders of the Yacht Division of Federagenti are pleased to announce that Mr. Fulvio Luise (Naples Division) has been elected the new President of Federagenti Yacht for 2011-2013.

Yacht traffic along our coastlines generates important investments for a large variety of businesses. Maritime agents are the most important catalyst, not only promote luxury yachting in our territory, but to showcase the best of what our country's coastlines have to offer."

"Federagenti Yacht, as an institutional organization, commits itself to find resolutions to issues that are not adequate for the rapidly increasing traffic in this sector. We work closely with maritime authorities and institutions, both Italian and European, to identify problems and propose solutions for issues that challenge the yachting industry in Italy. We hope to assist those who are often penalized as a result of these problems, most often, unjustly, in comparison to other European countries."

"In addition, Federagenti Yacht will continue to monitor, evaluate and study the marketplace, building upon the work that began over two years ago."

About us:

The Yacht Division of Federagenti was founded in 2005 with the objective to support the over 50 maritime agents belonging to Federagenti. They provide, on a daily basis, assistance to vessels, both motor and sailing, over 25 meters. A recent study by Federagenti Yacht in Italy estimated that in 2009 there were over 6,200 mega yacht port calls with an average stay of 3 days resulting in an economic impact of over 200 million Euro. In total, Federagenti Yacht estimates over 1,000 vessels, over 30 meters, are cruising in the Mediterranean which generate over 1 billion Euro and suggests a potential economic impact for Italy of over 800 million Euro.
